



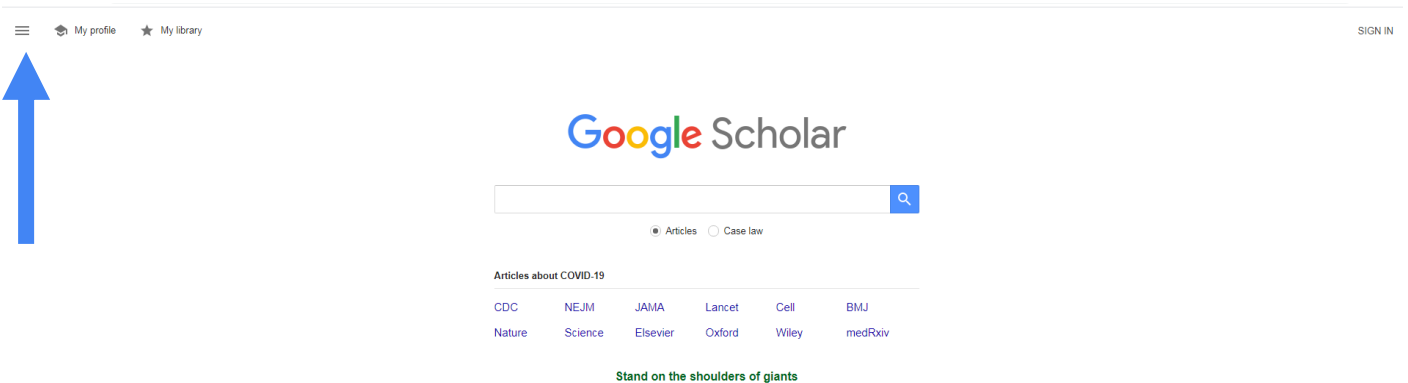

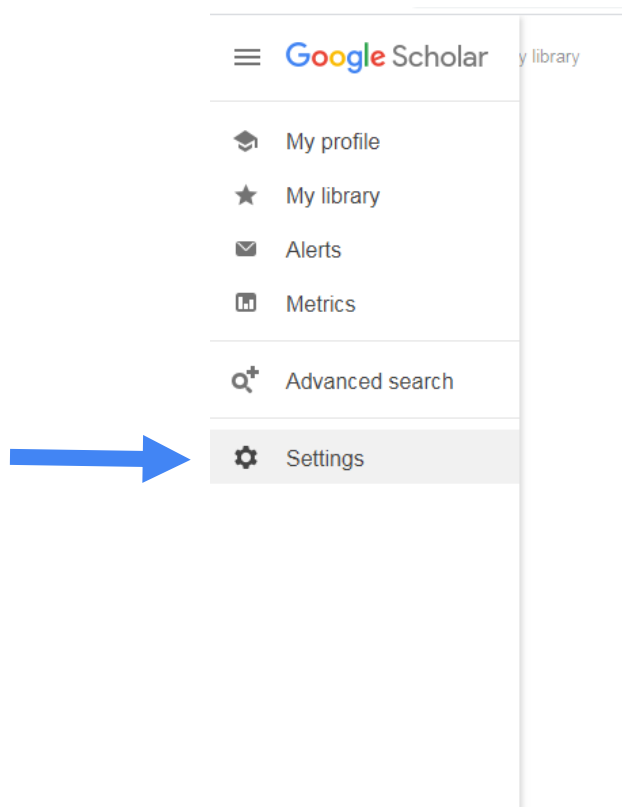
Linking the Library to Google Scholar

Google Scholar settings allows you to connect to our library & Knowledge Service providing you direct access to our electronic resources.

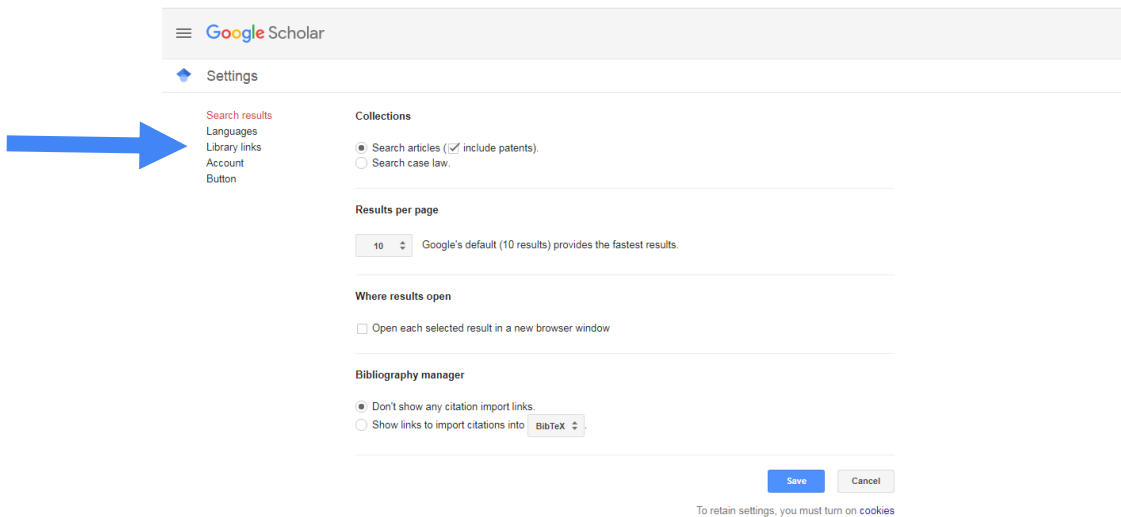
Go to [Google Scholar](#)—click on the three lines in the top left hand corner.



Clicking on the three lines—will expand the Google Scholar Menu (see below) - now click on ‘Settings’.



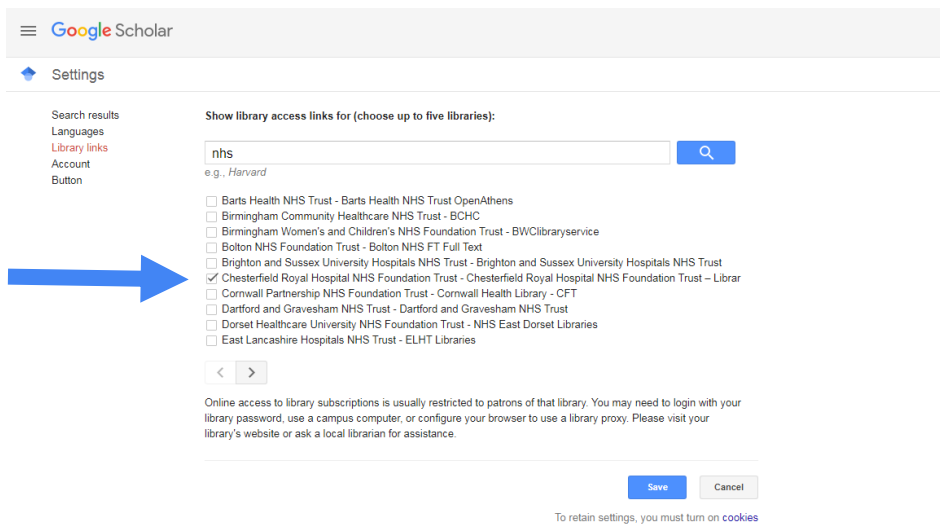
Under Settings, click on **'Library Links'**.



In the **'Library Links'** section enter **'NHS'** in the search box and click on the search icon.

When the results appear check the box next to the result **'Chesterfield Royal Hospital NHS Foundation Trust – Library & Knowledge Service'** and uncheck any other boxes.

Then click on the **'Save'** button (at the bottom of the page).



Now when you search Google Scholar you will see on the right hand side of the results, a row of links. If we have a subscription for an article, you will see a link titled, 'Chesterfield Royal Hospital....' when you click on the link you will be able to access the full text of an article immediately.
